Join us for worship any Sunday at 9:00 am followed by a time of fellowship.

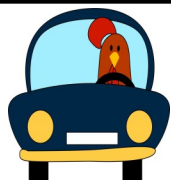

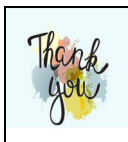
