RESOLUTION NO. 2015-02R

A Resolution of the Borough of Watsontown, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, establishing rates and late payment charges for electric customers of the Watsontown Borough Electric System.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Borough of Watsontown, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

The Borough Resolution of December 5, 1988 as amended on July 11, 1994, May 3, 1999, February 7, 2000, March 12, 2001, February 3, 2003, February 2, 2004, March 7, 2005, September 26, 2005, January 17, 2006, December 18, 2006, December 7, 2009, December 20, 2010, December 14, 2011, December 17, 2012, December 15, 2014 and Borough Regulations for Municipal Services of July 2, 2002, are hereby further amended as follows:

Section 1. ELECTRICITY shall be amended as follows:

The Provision of Electricity shall be subject to the following terms and rates:

RATE R

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

<u>Availability</u>: Available to customers taking service for household and other related uses in a single private dwelling or an individual dwelling in a multiple dwelling structure and in appurtenant detached buildings.

<u>Character of Service:</u> Alternating current, 60 hertz, single phase: 120 volts, 2 wire, 120-208 volts, 3 wire, or 120-240 volts, 3 wire.

<u>Contact Term and Billing:</u> Contracts shall be for a term of one (1) year with monthly payments for service taken.

Rate R - Residential Service

\$10.66 per month customer charge

PLUS

20.43 cents per KWH for the first 400 KWH 16.12 cents per KWH for all additional KWH

The minimum monthly rate is \$10.66

RATE G

SMALL GENERAL SERVICE

Availability: Available to customers taking general light and power service at a delivery point.

<u>Character of Service:</u> Alternating current, 60 hertz, 3 phase, 120-240 volts, 4 wires; 120-208 volts, 4 wire, 240 volts, 3 wire; 480 volts, 3 wire, or 270-480 volts, 4 wire, may be supplied.

Contract Term and Billing: Contracts shall be for a term of not less than one (1) year with monthly payments for service taken. Contracts for a longer term may be required where new investments by the Borough are necessary.

\$16.15 per month including the first 10 KW of the billing KW \$16.15 per Kilowatt for all additional kilowatts of the billing KW

PLUS

18.27 cents per KWH for the first 4000 KWH

14.48 cents per KWH for the next 100 KWH per kilowatt of the billing KW

11.62 cents per KWH for the next 150 KWH per kilowatt of the billing KW

10.49 cents per KWH for all additional KWH

The net monthly minimum is the charge under the rate applying the minimum billing demand of 10 KW with Zero (0) KWH use.

<u>Billing KW:</u> The billing KW shall be determined by one (1) of the following methods at the option of the Borough:

- a) Determined by estimate, calculation or test at the estimated time of maximum use.
- b) Measured by meters which will either indicate or record, at the option of the Borough, the highest fifteen minute demand in kilowatts during the month.

RATE LP

LARGE POWER SERVICE

Availability: Available to customers taking general light and power service at a delivery point and whose minimum demand is not less than two hundred (200) kilowatts.

<u>Character of Service</u>: Alternating current, 60 hertz, 3 phase, 12470 volts with one (1) transformer to a lower voltage with metering on the primary side of transformers and substation equipment.

Secondary Service: Service may be metered at the secondary voltage of transforming equipment at the option of the Borough. When so metered, energy charges will be increased by five percent (5%).

Equipment Credit: Where all substation and transforming equipment is owned and maintained by the customers, the Borough will allow a credit of ten percent (10%) of the demand charge.

Contract Term and Billing:

\$15.40 per kilowatt for the first 200 kilowatts of the billing KW \$10.45 per kilowatt for all additional kilowatts of the billing KW PLUS

12.95 cents per KWH for the first 150 KWH per kilowatt of the billing KW 10.87 cents per KWH for the next 100 KWH per kilowatt of the billing KW

9.74 cents per KWH for the next 150 KWH per kilowatt of the billing KW

8.76 cents per KWH for all additional KWH

The net monthly rate minimum is the charge under the rate applying the minimum billing demand of two hundred (200) KW with zero (0) KWH used.

<u>Billing KW:</u> The billing KW shall be determined by one (1) of the following methods at the option of the Borough:

- a) Determined by estimate, calculation or test at the estimated time of maximum use.
- b) Measured by meters which will either indicate or record, at the option of the Borough, the highest fifteen minute demand in kilowatts during the month.

For Large Power Service Customers with a billing KW in excess of 500 KW, a 20 percent discount in the demand charge shall apply.

RATE PS

PUBLIC SCHOOL RATE

Availability: Applicable to public schools and buildings owned and operated by the regional school district within the Borough.

<u>Character of Service:</u> Alternating current, 60 hertz, 3 phase, 120-240 volts, 4 wires; 120-208 volts, 4 wire, 240 volts, 3 wire; 480 volts, 3 wire, or 270-480 volts, 4 wire, may be supplied.

Contract Term and Billing: Contracts shall be for a term of not less than one (1) year with monthly payments for service taken. Contracts for a longer term may be required where new investments by the Borough are necessary.

\$12.92 per month including the first 10 KW of the billing KW \$12.92 per Kilowatt for all additional kilowatts of the billing KW

PLUS

- 14.62 cents per KWH for the first 4000 KWH
- 11.58 cents per KWH for the next 100 KWH per kilowatt of the billing KW
- 9.30 cents per KWH for the next 150 KWH per kilowatt of the billing KW
- 8.39 cents per KWH for all additional KWH

The net monthly minimum is the charge under the rate applying the minimum billing demand of 10 KW with Zero (0) KWH use.

<u>Billing KW</u>: The billing KW shall be determined by one (1) of the following methods at the option of the Borough:

- a) Determined by estimate, calculation or test at the estimated time of maximum use.
- b) Measured by meters which will either indicate or record, at the option of the Borough, the highest fifteen minute demand in kilowatts during the month.

TIME OF USE AND DEMAND RESPONSE METERING

Time of use metering is available on request for an additional charge equal to the cost of the new meter. Demand response KYZ contacts are available for an additional charge equal to the cost of the new meter.

PURCHASED POWER COST ADJUSTMENT (PPCA)

Applicable to all rate classes.

Each monthly bill may also include a positive or a negative Purchased Power Cost Adjustment (PPCA) Factor to reflect the changes in the Borough's actual purchased power cost.

The PPCA shall be applied to each kilowatt-hour (KWH) supplied under all rate schedules. This adjustment determined to the nearest 0.01 mill in accordance with the formula set forth below shall be applied to all kilowatt-hours supplied during the billing period. For months when the difference of (C-B) is less than zero, then the factor of (D/E) shall be set to 1.

$$A = (C-B) \times (D/E)$$

A = The amount of purchased power adjustment per kilowatt-hour to be applied to all bills.

C = The total current cost of power purchased from the Borough's power suppliers determined by dividing the total cost of power, including all costs, by the kilowatt hours purchased during the first preceding calendar month prior to the billing date.

B = Base purchased power cost, set by resolution.

D = Total kilowatt-hours purchased by the Borough from all power suppliers for the 12 preceding months.

E = Total kilowatt-hours sold by the Borough for the 12 proceeding calendar months.

The PPCA shall be computed monthly.

Regulations for Municipal Services shall be amended as follows:

Payment: Bills for municipal services, including electric, will be issued the month following consumption and shall be due by the 25th day of the month in which bills are issued. Bills not paid by the 25th of the month may be assessed a one time late payment charge of ten percent of the total amount due.

Section IV, EFFECTIVE RATES, shall be amended as follows:

The Electric Rates and late payment will become effective on the March 2, 2015
