All reservations are on a 1st come, 1st reserved basis. Reservations for Pavilions 1, 2 & the River Pavilion will not be accepted without payment.

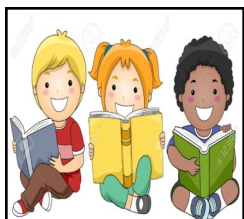
