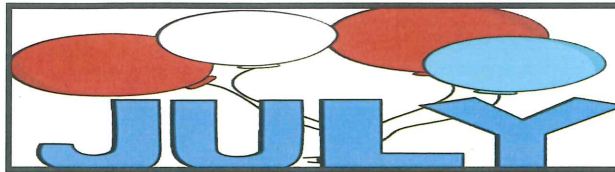

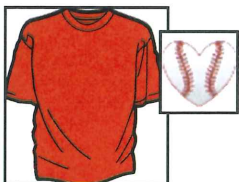

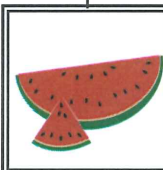


Scott Snyder Memorial Heart Walk
