1. Request your items using one of these methods:
  - a. Use your library card online to place holds within our catalog.
  - b. Leave a phone message.
  - c. Send an email request: [director@mghlib.org](mailto:director@mghlib.org)
  - d. Send a Facebook request: @mghlib
2. Wait for notification – depending on your request method, you may receive a call, text, or email – then call us when you plan to pick up. Staff will check out & bag up your items with your name labeled on the bag.
3. Call us when you arrive. We will place bagged items outside on a cart for you to pick up.

Please wear a mask when picking up your items & maintain social distancing with other customers. All items must be returned in the book drop, which you can do at your convenience. Call us if you have questions.
