 Available in Upper Northumberland County - SHARE Housing.

SHARE or Shared Housing and Resource Exchange is a housing model in **Union, Snyder and upper Northumberland counties**. Both Host and Seeker benefit from this agreed upon housing arrangement. Homeowners are provided with rent and/or resources such as making a meal, companionship. Home seekers are provided with a home and resources if needed. The program is open to anyone over 18. When a match is made, at least one party must be over 60 years of age. Host must have an extra bedroom to participate.
