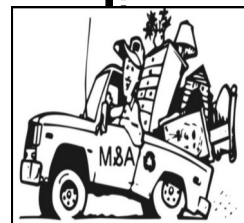

2022 Spring Clean-up Days
May 16th, 17th & 18th, 2022

Each street will be covered only **ONCE**. All items must be placed at the CURB. **NO** collections in the alleys. **ALL** items must be boxed, bagged or placed in containers and may **NOT** weigh more than **50 pounds**. Paint and roof cement cans or similar items will only be accepted if they contain **NO LIQUIDS** (all lids must be loose). **THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED:** Building materials, batteries, grass clippings, chemicals, spoiled foodstuff, garbage, flammable materials, metal/plastic barrels, burn barrels, mattresses, motor oil, tires, plaster, blocks and bricks. **The Covered Device Recycling Act** also prohibits the disposal of computers, mice, televisions, laptops, printers, notebooks, computer monitors, keyboards and any other device that provides input or output from the computer.

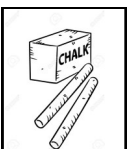

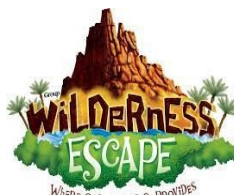
