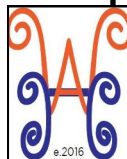

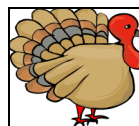

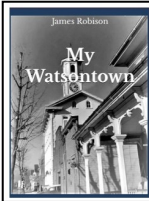
Warrior Run Womans Club is
