The 26th Amendment requires that 18-year-olds must be able to vote, however, states can allow persons younger than 18 to vote if they choose. The qualifications for voters are left to the states, as long as they do not conflict with anything in the Constitution. Study the Amendments and the Constitution!

We're growing larger so don't miss out on this opportunity to get out, meet and support the vendors of our great community!

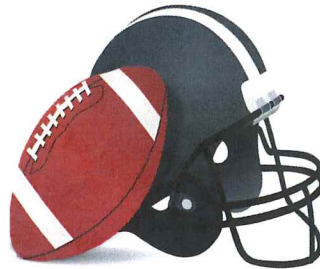
**VENDORS WANTED!!!**
