LEWIS TOWNSHIP RECYCLING DROP OFF FACILITY OPEN ON A LIMITED SCHEDULE

Due to Lycoming County – Lycoming

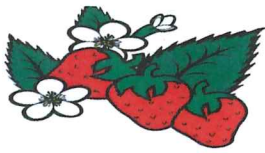

- Wait for notification – depending on your request method, you may receive a call, text, or email – then call us when you plan to pick up. Staff will check out & bag up your items with your name labeled on the bag.
